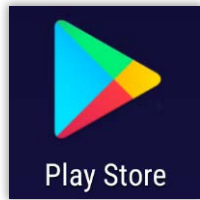
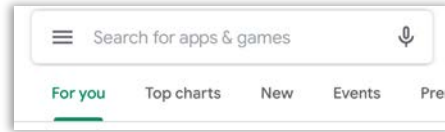


# Connecting to Zoom on Android Phones

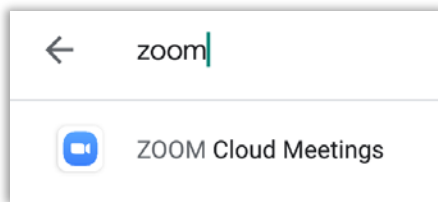
1. Go to the home screen and open the “**Play Store**” (Note: It may be on another page):



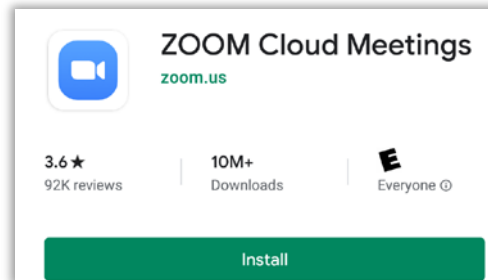
2. Select the **Search box** at the top of the page:



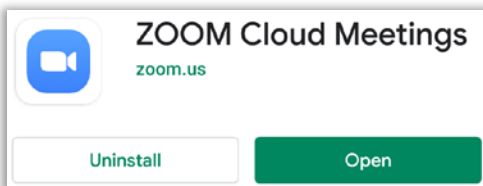
3. Type “**Zoom**” in the search box and click the **[Search]** button in the bottom right:



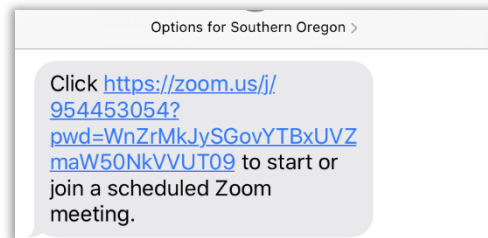
4. Click on “**Zoom Cloud Meetings**” and click **[Install]** on the next screen:



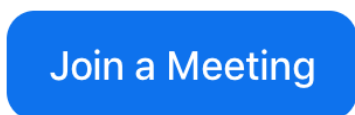
5. When the app install finishes, click **[Open]**:



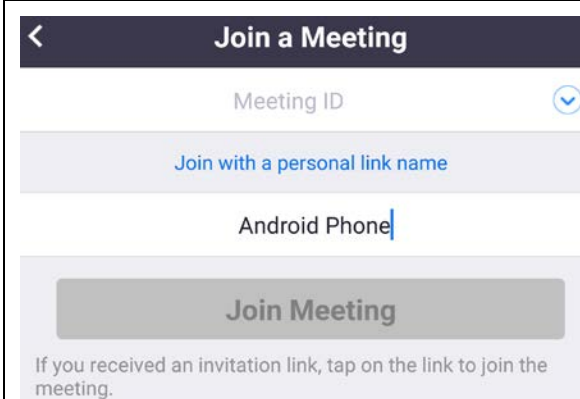
6. When Zoom is finished installing, if you got a meeting link in a text message, click on the **link** in the message. **Skip to step 12.**



7. Click **[Join a Meeting]**:

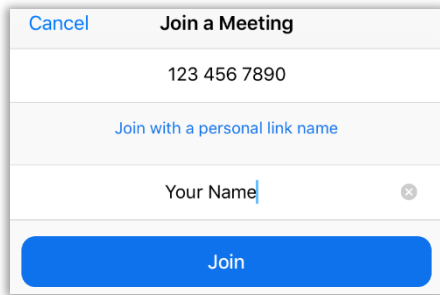


8. In the “Meeting ID” box at the top of the screen, enter the **Meeting ID** you received:

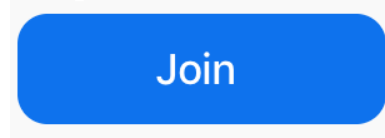

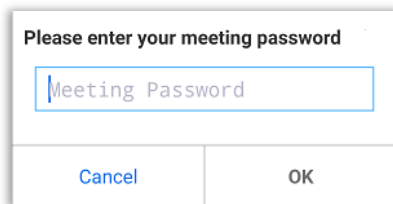
9. In the second box, erase your Phone's name by clicking on the [X] button and enter **your name**:



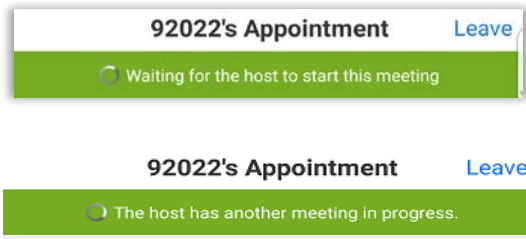
10. Click **[Join]** :



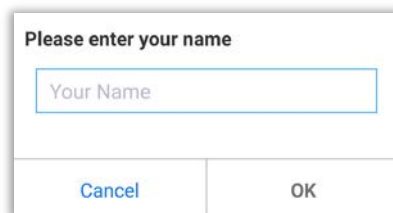
11. If **prompted**, enter the password you received and click **[Continue]**:



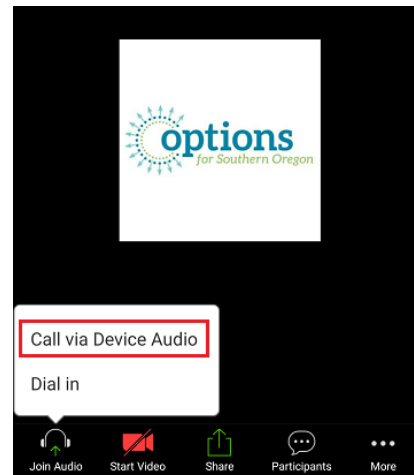
